





CANNES

DAY 1

You will board **BAGHEERA** in Cannes Old Port and will be welcomed with a cocktail and buffet lunch, while we will be cruising South of Cannes, to the islands of Sainte Marguerite and Saint Honorat.

We will anchor around the islands for a swim and enjoyment with the toys on board. A tender can be taken ashore for a nice walk on the islands.

In the evening, we will head back to Cannes Marina where you could visit the old quarter of Cannes with narrow alleys, many restaurants, and a beautiful view from the top; very picturesque and in contrast with the cosmopolitan nature of Cannes.







MONACO

DAY 2

Monaco has so much to offer, including restaurants, shopping and sightseeing. If the hustle and bustle is too much, Cap Martin provides a nice anchorage just outside the port, returning back to Monaco for the evening.

In Monaco, you could see the beautiful Palais du Prince, the official residence of Prince Albert of Monaco, which was built in 1191 as a fortress and as such there are numerous cannons arrayed around the front of the structure.

In the evening, you could have dinner ashore in one of the many Michelin star restaurants or trying your hand at the roulette table at the legendary Monte Carlo Casino.







VILLEFRANCHE-SUR-MER / ST JEAN CAP FERRAT DAY ${\bf 3}$

Lift anchor in the morning and cruise to Villefranche for lunch on board in the beautiful bay, with swimming and relaxing time.

The bay gives a few different anchorages whether it is close to Cap Ferrat, Beaulieu-sur-Mer or at the base of the medieval village of Eze perched high above the sea.

A steep sided bay, Villefranche is a relaxed resort that retains much of the architecture and character of centuries gone by.







ANTIBES

DAY 4

Cruise to Antibes and anchor off on either side of Cap d'Antibes, a peninsula between Nice and Cannes where the marina, overlooked by an ancient stone castle, harbors many of the world's largest yachts, and gives an amazing view of the coast.

Enjoy some time ashore in the only Michelin star restaurant "Les Vieux Murs" and take in the Picasso Museum at Chateau Grimaldi. Anchor off the old wall.







ST TROPEZ

DAY 5

Depart early from Antibes, heading towards St Tropez and discover Pampelonne beach, an extraordinarily long beach said to be the home of the bikini and one its early proponents, Brigitte Bardot, with its array of beach bars including Le Club 55 and Tahiti beach to name a few.

Once the day draws to a close its a short trip round the head land to St Tropez where it needs no introduction. Dine ashore at Alain Ducasse's Spoon at Hotel Byblos.

If you need to relax, the Chateau Spa is nestled at the heart of the Chateau De La Messardière hotel. Bathed in natural light, the 465m² Château Spa is a sensual world entirely dedicated to pampering and wellbeing.







ST TROPEZ / PORQUEROLLES

DAY 6

This large island in the Gulf of Hyères with its cool forests of windtwisted parasol pines and traditional villages is unusual, welcoming and rigidly protected against development; break out the bikes as no cars are allowed. Sample fine Provençal cuisine at Le Mas du Langoustier.

DAY 7

Back to Cannes marina, and if you fancy an early start of your day, you could take advantage of the market with all the beautiful smells and colors coming from the fresh products.

Cannes also offers great shopping areas where you will find high fashion and famous ready-to-wear clothing, jewellers, perfume shops, beauty parlors, decoration stores and art galleries, which compete with Paris, Milan, London, New York or Dubai.
